A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in master-metered

2 condominiums, electric power consumption for the entire building

3 is divided among the units. Since the electricity costs of each

4 unit change very little in proportion to a unit's increased or

5 decreased consumption, residents in master-metered condominiums

6 have little incentive to conserve electricity and therefore tend

to consume more electricity than residents who do not reside in

8 master-metered condominiums.

9 The legislature further finds that changing condominiums

from master-metered to sub-metered, where each apartment unit is

11 charged for that unit's electricity consumption, reduces total

12 building electricity consumption by ten to twenty-six per cent.

13 The purpose of this Act is to establish a working group to

address the installation of electrical sub-meters in

15 condominiums.

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1	SECT:	ION 2. (a) There is established the condominium sub-
2	meter wor	king group within the department of business, economic
3	developme	nt, and tourism for administrative purposes.
4	(b)	The working group shall examine the financial,
5	technical	, administrative, and other issues regarding the
6	installat	ion of electrical sub-meters in new and existing
7	condomini	um projects.
8	(c)	The following individuals or their designees shall
9	serve as	members of the working group:
10	(1)	The director of business, economic development, and
11		tourism, who shall serve as the chairperson of the
12		working group;
13	(2)	The director of commerce and consumer affairs;
14	(3)	The chairperson of the public utilities commission;
15	(4)	The chairperson of the senate standing committee with
16		jurisdiction over energy matters;
17	(5)	The chairperson of the house of representatives
18		standing committee with jurisdiction over energy
19		matters;
20	(6)	The chairperson of the senate standing committee with

jurisdiction over consumer protection matters; and

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- (7) The chairperson of the house of representatives
 standing committee with jurisdiction over consumer
 protection matters.
- 4 (d) The director of business, economic development, and
 5 tourism, shall invite representatives from the following to
 6 serve as members of the working group:
- 7 (1) The community associations institute;
- 8 (2) Hawaiian Electric Industries;
- 9 (3) A utility cooperative;
- 10 (4) The solar industry; and
- 11 (5) The storage and distributed energy resources industry.
- 12 (e) Members of working group shall receive no compensation
- 13 for their service on the working group but shall be reimbursed
- 14 from reasonable expenses incurred, including travel expenses,
- 15 related to their service on the working group.
- 16 (f) The working group shall report its findings and
- 17 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 18 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 19 the regular session of 2017.
- 20 (g) The legislative reference bureau shall assist the
- 21 working group with editing its report and proposed legislation,

- 1 if any; provided that the draft report and proposed legislation
- 2 are provided to the bureau by November 1, 2016.
- 3 (h) The working group shall be dissolved on December 30,
- 4 2016.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
