## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in master-metered

2 condominiums, electric power consumption for the entire building

3 is divided among the units. Since the electricity costs of each

4 unit change very little in proportion to a unit's increased or

5 decreased consumption, residents in master-metered condominiums

have little incentive to conserve electricity and therefore tend

7 to consume more electricity than residents who do not reside in

master-metered condominiums.

9 The legislature further finds that changing condominiums

from master-metered to sub-metered, where each apartment unit is

charged for that unit's electricity consumption, reduces total

12 building electricity consumption by ten to twenty-six per cent.

13 The purpose of this Act is to establish a working group to

14 address the installation of electrical sub-meters in

15 condominiums.

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1	SECT	ION 2. (a) There is established the condominium sub-
2	meter wor	king group within the department of business, economic
3	developme	nt, and tourism for administrative purposes.
4	(b)	The working group shall examine the financial,
5	technical	, administrative, and other issues regarding the
6	installat	ion of electrical sub-meters in new and existing
7	condomini	um projects.
8	(c)	The following individuals or their designees shall
9	serve as	members of the working group:
10	(1)	The director of business, economic development, and
11		tourism, who shall serve as the chairperson of the
12		working group;
13	(2)	The director of commerce and consumer affairs;
14	(3)	The director of the department of planning and
15		permitting of the city and county of Honolulu;
16	(4)	The chairperson of the senate standing committee with
17		jurisdiction over energy matters;
18	(5)	The chairperson of the house of representatives
19		standing committee with jurisdiction over energy
20		matters;

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1	(6) The chairperson of the senate standing committee with
2	jurisdiction over consumer protection matters; and
3	(7) The chairperson of the house of representatives
4	standing committee with jurisdiction over consumer
5	protection matters.
6	(d) The director of business, economic development, and
7	tourism, shall invite representatives from the following to
8	serve as members of the working group:
9	(1) The Community Associations Institute;
10	(2) Hawaiian Electric Industries;
11	(3) A utility cooperative;
12	(4) Local Union 1186 IBEW;
13	(5) The solar industry; and
14	(6) The storage and distributed energy resources industry
15	(e) Members of working group shall receive no compensation
16	for their service on the working group but shall be reimbursed
17	from reasonable expenses incurred, including travel expenses,
18	related to their service on the working group.
19	(f) The working group shall report its findings and
20	recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the

- 1 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 2 the regular session of 2017.
- 3 (g) The legislative reference bureau shall assist the
- 4 working group with editing its report and proposed legislation,
- 5 if any; provided that the draft report and proposed legislation
- 6 are provided to the bureau by November 1, 2016.
- 7 (h) The working group shall be dissolved on December 30,
- 8 2016.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
