A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 107-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§107-24 Authority and duties of the council. (a) Any
- 4 law to the contrary notwithstanding, the council shall establish
- 5 the Hawaii state building codes.
- 6 (b) The council shall appoint a subcommittee comprising
- 7 the four council members representing county building officials,
- 8 whose duty shall be to recommend any necessary or desirable
- 9 state amendments to the codes and standards identified in
- 10 section 107-25. Any recommended state amendments shall require
- 11 the unanimous agreement of the subcommittee.
- 12 (c) The council shall adopt, amend, or update codes and
- 13 standards identified in section 107-25 on a staggered basis, as
- 14 established by the council; provided that the adoption,
- 15 amendment, or update of any code or standard shall be:
- 16 (1) At least once every six years; and

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1	(2)	Based upon a review and evaluation of the utility of
2		the code or standard at the time each respective
3		edition is published.

- 4 (d) The council may appoint other investigative, technical 5 expertise committees, which may include council members.
- 6 (e) The council shall consult with general building
 7 contractor associations and building trade associations to
 8 gather information and recommendations on construction practices
 9 and training relevant to building codes and standards.
- 10 (f) The council shall review and adopt, as appropriate,
 11 new model building codes within eighteen months of the official
 12 publication date.
- (g) The council may grant exemptions or make modifications
 to the state building codes to conform with county building
 codes pursuant to section 107-28(c); provided that nothing in
 this subsection shall be construed to limit the ability of a
 county to amend the state building codes as they apply within
 the county's respective jurisdiction pursuant to sections 4619 1.5(13) and 107-28(a).
- 20 [(g)] (h) The council may make expenditures for technical references, equipment and supplies, and other operating

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- 1 expenses, and may contract for the conduct of research studies
- 2 and other technical services.
- 3 [\(\frac{(h)}{}\)] (i) The council may provide education and technical
- 4 training and administrative assistance in the form of services
- 5 or grants at the state and county levels relating to the
- 6 implementation and enforcement of the Hawaii state building
- 7 codes adopted pursuant to this part.
- 8 [(i)] (j) At the end of each fiscal year, the council
- 9 shall submit a written report to the governor on the council's
- 10 activities, including the codes and standards adopted, amended,
- 11 or updated by the council."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 107-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 "§107-28 County authority to amend and adopt the Hawaii
- 15 state building codes without council approval. (a) The
- 16 governing body of each county shall amend, adopt, and update the
- 17 Hawaii state building codes as they apply within their
- 18 respective jurisdiction, in accordance with section 46-1.5(13),
- 19 without approval of the council. Each county shall amend and
- 20 adopt the Hawaii state building codes and standards listed in
- 21 section 107-25, as the referenced Hawaii state building codes

- 1 and standards for its respective county building code ordinance,
- 2 no later than two years after the adoption of the Hawaii state
- 3 building codes.
- 4 (b) If a county does not amend the Hawaii state building
- 5 codes within the two-year time frame, the Hawaii state building
- 6 codes shall become applicable as an interim county building
- 7 code.
- 8 (c) A county may appeal to the council a requirement of
- 9 the statewide building codes and seek an exemption or
- 10 modification to the codes for that county pursuant to section
- **11** 107-24 (g) . "
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
