A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR KALOKO RESERVOIR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds and declares that the
- 2 issuance of special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in
- 3 the public interest and for the public health, safety, and
- 4 general welfare.
- 5 SECTION 2. Pursuant to Act , Session Laws of Hawaii
- 6 2016, the department of budget and finance, with the approval of
- 7 the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose revenue
- 8 bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 in one or more
- 9 series, for the purpose of providing financing to Mary N. Lucas
- 10 Estate for the Kaloko reservoir for planning, permitting,
- 11 designing, constructing, and equipping the reservoir's dam,
- 12 upgrading the infrastructure associated with the dam, and
- 13 acquiring the neighboring properties and appurtenant water
- 14 system rights and assets necessary to restore and operate the
- 15 appurtenant water system. The legislature hereby finds and
- 16 determines that the Kaloko reservoir and its dam constitute a

1 project as defined in Act , Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, and 2 the financing thereof is assistance to dam and reservoir owners. 3 SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds and the 4 refunding special purpose revenue bonds issued under this Act 5 shall be issued pursuant to Act , Session Laws of Hawaii 6 2016, relating to the power to issue special purpose revenue 7 bonds to assist dam and reservoir owners. 8 SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is 9 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to 10 June 30, 2021, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in 11 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be 12 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized 13 in section 2 of this Act and to refund special purpose revenue bonds authorized by this section, regardless of whether the 14 15 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special 16 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of 17 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue 18 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in 19 section 2. In making this determination, the department shall 20 comply with federal law relating to the exemption from federal

- 1 income taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature
- 2 authorized by this section.
- 3 SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose
- 4 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2021.
- 5 SECTION 6. The revisor of statutes shall insert the act
- 6 number for H.B. No. 2058, as enacted by the legislature in the
- 7 2016 regular session, as the act referenced in sections 2 and 3.

8 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
