### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The department of education shall establish a
- 2 three-year pilot program that provides private school funding
- 3 levels to a public school. Specifically, the department shall
- 4 select any public elementary, middle, or high school in the
- 5 State, including a charter school, to receive funding for three
- 6 school years, beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, at a
- 7 level that is equivalent to the level of funding that Punahou
- 8 School provides to those same grade levels at Punahou School;
- 9 provided that funding information is provided by Punahou School
- 10 to the department of education and the level of funding at
- 11 Punahou School is higher than the level of funding for the
- 12 selected public school.
- 13 SECTION 2. The department of education shall use the pilot
- 14 program to determine whether student performance is affected by
- 15 an increase in funding levels.
- 16 SECTION 3. The department of education shall submit a
- 17 report of its findings and recommendations, including any

- 1 proposed legislation, to the legislature not later than twenty
- 2 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2020.
- 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
- 6 pilot program established under this Act.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
