
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$31,500,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the fourth representative district, as follows:

7 1. County of Hawaii

8 A. Puna, Hawaii

9 Construction of a bypass road
10 between Keaau and Hawaiian
11 paradise park.

12 Total funding \$15,000,000

13 B. Champagne ponds, Kapoho, Hawaii

14 Construction of a restroom with
15 solar composting toilets.

16 Total funding \$300,000



1 C. Pahoehoe, Hawaii
2 Planning, design, and construction
3 of a wastewater treatment plant.
4 Total funding \$15,000,000

5 D. Bay clinic, Keaau, Hawaii
6 Land improvements and construction
7 of a new bay clinic facility in
8 Keaau.
9 Total funding \$350,000

10 2. Department of education

11 A. Pahoehoe elementary school, Pahoehoe, Hawaii
12 Improvements and repair of
13 covered walkways
14 Total funding \$200,000

15 3. Department of land and natural resources

16 A. Milolii, Hawaii
17 Construction of a photovoltaic
18 electrical and water system for
19 the Paa Pono Milolii community
20 center.
21 Total funding \$350,000

2 Construction of the Pohoiki boat
3 ramp in Kapoho.


4 Total funding \$300,000

5 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
6 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
7 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
8 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
9 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
11 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
