A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION DIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that timely review of 2 department of transportation projects by the state historic
- 3 preservation division in the department of land and natural
- 4 resources is essential for the protection of historic properties
- 5 in the State, as well as the expeditious implementation of
- 6 department of transportation initiatives. Currently, the speed
- 7 at which the historic preservation division is able to review
- $oldsymbol{8}$ department of transportation projects is severely limited by the
- 9 size of its staff.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to enhance the capabilities of
- 11 the state historic preservation division to expeditiously review
- 12 department of transportation project proposals by creating and
- 13 funding two additional positions in the state historic
- 14 preservation division.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) There are hereby established within the
- 16 state historic preservation division in the department of land
- 17 and natural resources two full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE)

- 1 permanent positions consisting of an archaeologist IV position
- 2 and an office assistant III position.
- 3 (b) These positions may be initially filled as exempt
- 4 positions while they are being classified in the civil service.
- 5 (c) These positions shall be available on the effective
- 6 date of this Act or as soon thereafter as the department of
- 7 transportation makes funds available to the state historic
- 8 preservation division in the department of land and natural
- 9 resources.
- (d) These positions shall be funded by the Hawaii historic
- 11 preservation fund pursuant to section 6E-16, Hawaii Revised
- 12 Statutes.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
