BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 346-29, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 3 "(e) The director shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
- 4 defining assets and to determine eligibility for medical
- 5 assistance; provided that the cash surrender value of life
- 6 insurance policies owned by persons included in an application
- 7 shall be treated as assets. Rules determining asset and income
- 8 thresholds for eligibility for medicaid assistance shall provide
- 9 for annual cost of living increases or federal poverty level
- 10 increases, whichever are greater, as allowed by the Secretary of
- 11 Health and Human Services by means of indexing, court order, or
- 12 fair hearing decree."
- 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
