A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATURE, THE AUDITOR, THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, THE OMBUDSMAN, AND THE ETHICS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$8,878,376 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary to the senate for the following
- 4 expenses:
- 5 (1) The sum of \$7,615,876 for defraying any and all
- 6 session and nonsession expenses of the senate up to
- 7 and including June 30, 2017, including the 2016
- 8 regular session, twenty-eighth legislature of the
- 9 State of Hawaii, and pre-session expenses and the
- 10 expenses of any committee or committees established
- during the interim between the 2016 and 2017 regular
- 12 sessions;
- 13 (2) The sum of \$1,150,000 for defraying the expenses of
- 14 the legislative information system for cost items such
- as hardware, software, consultants, installation,
- 16 materials, supplies, and other related costs

1	associated with the legislative system that have been
2	or will be incurred; and
3	(3) The sum of \$112,500 for defraying the cost of the
4	legislative broadcasting program to pay for the
5	production and distribution of television broadcasts
6	of legislative proceedings.
7	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
8	the senate.
9	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,130,374 or so
11	much thereof as may be necessary to the house of representatives
12	for the following expenses:
13	(1) The sum of \$11,079,450 for defraying any and all
14	session and nonsession expenses of the house of
15	representatives up to and including June 30, 2017,
16	including the 2016 regular session, twenty-eighth
17	legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session
18	expenses and the expenses of any committee or
19	committees established during the interim between the

2016 and 2017 regular sessions;

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1	(2)	The sum of \$938,424 for defraying the expenses of the
2		legislative information system for cost items such as
3		hardware, software, consultants, installation,
4		materials, supplies, and other related costs
5		associated with the legislative information system
6		that have been or will be incurred; and
7	(3)	The sum of \$112,500 for defraying the cost of the
8		legislative broadcasting program to pay for the
9		production and distribution of television broadcasts
10		of legislative proceedings.
11	The	sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
12	the house	of representatives.
13	SECT	ION 3. Payment of expenses of the senate during the
14	interim b	etween the 2016 and 2017 regular sessions shall be made
15	only with	the approval of the president of the senate, and
16	payment o	f expenses of the house of representatives during the
17	interim b	etween the 2016 and 2017 regular sessions shall be made
18	only with	the approval of the speaker of the house of
19	represent	atives.
20	SECT	ION 4. Before January 18, 2017, the senate and the
21	house of	representatives shall each have their accounts audited,

1	and a full report of the respective audits shall be presented to		
2	the senate and to the house of representatives convening on		
3	January 18, 2017.		
4	SECTION 5. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the		
5	expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad		
6	on official business of the legislature shall be \$145 a day as		
7	authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of the		
8	house of representatives.		
9	SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general		
10	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,978,549 or so much		
11	thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor for the		
12	following expenses:		
13	(1) The sum of \$2,828,549 for defraying the expenses of		
14	the office of the auditor during fiscal year 2016-		
15	2017; and

(2) The sum of \$150,000 during fiscal year 2016-2017 for:

10	SECTION 7	. There is appropriated out of the general			
11	revenues of th	e State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,800,000 or so much			
12	thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor during				
13	fiscal year 2016-2017 to be deposited into the audit revolving				
14	fund established pursuant to section 23-3.6, Hawaii Revised				
15	Statutes.				
16	SECTION 8	. There is appropriated out of the audit			
17	revolving fund	the sum of \$6,300,000 or so much thereof as may			
18	be necessary t	o the office of the auditor during fiscal year			
19	2016-2017 for the office to conduct or complete its audit				
20	functions as n	crowided by law			

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the
- 2 auditor.
- 3 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,463,419 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary to the legislative reference bureau
- 6 for defraying the expenses of the legislative reference bureau
- 7 during fiscal year 2016-2017, including equipment relating to
- 8 computer systems programming and operations.
- 9 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 10 the legislative reference bureau.
- 11 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,216,970 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the ombudsman for
- 14 defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year 2016-
- **15** 2017.
- 16 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 17 office of the ombudsman.
- 18 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
- 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,009,695 or so much
- 20 thereof as may be necessary to the state ethics commission for

- 1 defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year 2016-
- 2 2017.
- 3 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 4 the state ethics commission.
- 5 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary to be expended for the purpose of
- 8 accrued vacation payments and vacation transfer payments for any
- 9 employee leaving the employ of the senate, house of
- 10 representatives, office of the auditor, legislative reference
- 11 bureau, office of the ombudsman, and state ethics commission:

funds from turnover and vacancy amounts; and provided further

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- 1 that any unexpended funds shall lapse to the general fund on
- 2 June 30, 2017.
- 3 SECTION 13. Except for moneys in the audit revolving fund,
- 4 as of the close of business on June 30, 2017, the unexpended or
- 5 unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act shall
- 6 lapse into the general fund.
- 7 SECTION 14. Each section of this Act is declared to be
- 8 severable from the remainder of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
