## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there has been on-
- 2 going dispute in planned community associations between members
- 3 and association boards regarding the right of members to display
- 4 the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of
- 5 Hawaii. In addition, there has been public outcry from members
- 6 of planned community associations who wish to display these
- 7 flags but have been prevented from doing so by association
- 8 boards through denials, fines, and the imposition of large fees.
- . 9 The purpose of this Act is to clarify the right of members
- 10 of planned community associations to display the United States
- 11 and State of Hawaii flags on their properties.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 14 and to read as follows:
- 15 "S421J- Display of house-mounted United States and State
- 16 of Hawaii flags. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,
- 17 no member or bona fide tenant of a member shall be prohibited by

- 1 any association document, covenant, declaration, bylaw,
- 2 restriction, deed, lease, term, provision, condition, codicil,
- 3 contract, or similar binding agreement, however worded, from
- 4 displaying a house-mounted United States or State of Hawaii flag
- 5 on any residential dwelling that the member owns or has rented
- 6 to a bona fide tenant; provided that the house-mounted flag
- 7 shaft shall not exceed six feet in length and the flag shall not
- 8 exceed three feet by five feet in size.
- 9 (b) No association or board of directors shall assess or
- 10 charge any member or bona fide tenant of a member any fee or
- 11 fine, or impose on any member or bona fide tenant of a member
- 12 any penalty for the house-mounted display of flags as provided
- in this section.
- 14 (c) Flags displayed pursuant to this section shall be
- 15 displayed in a prominent position on the residential dwelling;
- 16 provided that:
- 17 (1) United States flags shall be displayed in accordance
- 18 with the provisions of title 4 United States Code
- chapter 1; and
- 20 (2) State of Hawaii flags shall be displayed in accordance
- 21 with section 5-19 and consistent with the treatment of

3	(d) As used in this section, "house-mounted" means mounted
4	to a residential dwelling."

# H.B. NO. 2724

### Report Title:

Planned Community Associations; United States Flag; State of Hawaii Flag; Display

### Description:

Prohibits planned community associations and their boards of directors from: (1) disallowing a member or their bona fide tenant from displaying house-mounted United States or State of Hawaii flags on their residential dwelling; and (2) assessing or charging any fee or fine, or imposing any penalty, on their members, for house-mounted display of these flags. Requires the flags to be displayed in a prominent position on the residential dwelling.
