A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MILITARY IN THE ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's large
2	military community has a diverse range of experience and
3	interests and includes active duty military members, veterans,
4	and their families. Programs implemented through partnerships
5	with military bases, organizations, and veterans' assistance
6	agencies deliver a wide range of services, including:
7	(1) Healing arts, a program designed to address post-
8	traumatic stress disorder;
9	(2) After-school arts education programming for military
10	dependents;
11	(3) Performances on military bases or discounted rates for
12	military members at community events; and
13	(4) Participation programs in theater, dance, music,
14	visual arts, and literary and cultural activities.
15	The purpose of this Act is to encourage relevant
16	programming and partnerships between arts organizations and
17	military bases in the State, military organizations, and
18	veterans' assistance agencies to provide greater access to the

- 1 arts for active duty military members, veterans, and their
- 2 families, and to make a significant contribution to the quality
- 3 of life of the State's military community.
- 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 to
- 7 establish an arts in the military program.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state
- 9 foundation on culture and the arts for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
