## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE LANDS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that areas on public
- 2 lands that are susceptible to rockfall pose a serious hazard to
- 3 public safety, and that mitigation of these hazards is a matter
- 4 of statewide concern. However, the legislature also finds that
- 5 the State's exposure to liability for conducting rockfall
- 6 mitigation projects has hindered the State's ability to
- 7 successfully mitigate these hazards.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to provide civil immunity for
- 9 the State when conducting rockfall mitigation activities on
- 10 public lands.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 13 designated and to read as follows:
- 14 "S171- Rockfall mitigation; immunity from liability.
- 15 The department, the board, department employees, and department
- 16 agents shall be immune from liability for any civil action that

- 1 arises from an act or omission that occurs during the process of
- 2 conducting rockfall mitigation activities on public lands."
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
