A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DWELLING UNIT REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§20</u>	1H- County affordable housing subaccounts. (a) The
5	corporation, upon request by a county, may establish and operate	
6	an affordable housing subaccount for the benefit of the county	
7	within the dwelling unit revolving fund.	
8	(b) The corporation shall establish the following	
9	requirements for the establishment and operation of a county	
10	affordabl	e housing subaccount:
11	(1)	Matching loans and contributions of up to \$5,000,000
12		shall be made by the county and the dwelling unit
13		revolving fund into the county affordable housing
14		subaccount; and
15	(2)	A county affordable housing subaccount shall be
16		leveraged with private loans, contributions, and
17		moneys from other sources.

(c) An amount from each county affordable housing 1 2 subaccount, to be set by the corporation and authorized by the 3 legislature, may be used for administrative expenses incurred by 4 the corporation in administering the subaccount. 5 (d) The corporation shall adopt rules in accordance with 6 chapter 91 relating to the establishment, requirements, and 7 operation of county affordable housing subaccounts." 8 SECTION 2. Section 201H-191, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 9 10 "[+]S201H-191[+] Dwelling unit revolving fund. (a) There 11 is created a dwelling unit revolving fund. The funds 12 appropriated for the purpose of the dwelling unit revolving fund 13 and all moneys received or collected by the corporation for the 14 purpose of the revolving fund shall be deposited in the 15 revolving fund. The proceeds in the revolving fund shall be 16 used to reimburse the general fund to pay the interest on 17 general obligation bonds issued for the purposes of the 18 revolving fund, for the necessary expenses in administering 19 housing development programs, and for carrying out the purposes 20 of housing development programs, including but not limited to

the expansion of community facilities constructed in conjunction

- 1 with housing projects, permanent primary or secondary financing,
- 2 and supplementing building costs, federal guarantees required
- 3 for operational losses, and all things required by any federal
- 4 agency in the construction and receipt of federal funds or
- 5 low-income housing tax credits for housing projects.
- 6 (b) Subject to requirements of subsection (a), the
- 7 proceeds in the revolving fund may also be used for the purposes
- 8 of establishing and operating the county affordable housing
- 9 subaccounts as described in section 201H- ."
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
