A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JOHN A. BURNS SCHOOL OF MEDICINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to subpart B of part II to be
- 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§304A- John A. Burns school of medicine scholarship
- 5 program. (a) There is established the John A. Burns school of
- 6 medicine scholarship program to be administered by the John A.
- 7 Burns school of medicine of the University of Hawaii to assist
- 8 students with medical school tuition in return for a service
- 9 commitment to practice in the State.
- 10 (b) The scholarship program shall cover the cost of
- 11 tuition and fees for a complete course of study at the John A.
- 12 Burns school of medicine; provided that should a recipient fail
- 13 to maintain satisfactory academic progress, the recipient shall
- 14 be terminated from the scholarship program and shall be required
- 15 to pay back the portion of the scholarship already dispensed on
- 16 the recipient's behalf. Recipients shall be required to remain
- 17 in or return to the State and practice in the State for five

- 1 years following the completion of the recipient's residency. If
- 2 a recipient fails to complete the required five-year service
- 3 commitment, the recipient shall be required to reimburse the
- 4 University of Hawaii for the full amount of tuition and fees
- 5 received as part of the scholarship program.
- 6 (c) The number of scholarships awarded annually shall be
- 7 determined by the John A. Burns school of medicine and shall be
- 8 subject to the availability of funds.
- 9 (d) The John A. Burns school of medicine shall establish
- 10 necessary policies and procedures to implement and sustain the
- 11 scholarship program, including application procedures,
- 12 eligibility requirements, and standards to determine which
- 13 applicants are awarded scholarships."
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 17 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 18 2016-2017 for the John A. Burns school of medicine scholarship
- 19 program.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 21 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
