BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 601, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§601- Disclosure of judges' personal information
5	prohibited. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no agency
6	shall make available for public inspection or duplication any
7	government record of the home addresses, birthdates, and
8	personal telephone and cellular telephone numbers of full-time
9	justices and judges; the home addresses, personal telephone and
10	cellular telephone numbers, birthdates, and places of employment
11	of the spouses and children of the justices and judges; and the
12	names and locations of schools and child care facilities
13	attended by the children of the justices and judges. For the
14	purposes of this section, "agency" and "government record" shall
15	have the same meanings as provided in section 92F-3."
16	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
