A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OVERTAKING A BICYCLIST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to specify the safe
2	distance for a motor vehicle to overtake a bicycle.
3	SECTION 2. Section 291C-43, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended to read as follows:
5	"[+]\$291C-43[+] Overtaking a vehicle on the left. The
6	following rules shall govern the overtaking and passing of
7	vehicles proceeding in the same direction, subject to those
8	limitations, exceptions, and special rules hereinafter stated:
9	(1) The driver of a vehicle overtaking another vehicle
10	proceeding in the same direction shall pass to the
11	left thereof at a safe distance and shall not again
12	drive to the right side of the roadway until safely
13	clear of the overtaken vehicle[-]; provided that the
14	minimum safe distance for a motor vehicle to overtake
15	a bicycle is three feet; and
16	(2) Except when overtaking and passing on the right is
17	permitted, the driver of an overtaken vehicle shall

1	give way to the right in favor of the overtaking
2	vehicle on audible signal and shall not increase the
3	speed of the driver's vehicle until completely passed
4	by the overtaking vehicle."
5	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
