BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 4 SECTION 4. (a) The Hawaii tourism authority is authorized
- 5 to issue revenue bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 for a
- 7 grant-in-aid to the city and county of Honolulu to provide
- 8 financing for its rail transit project.
- 9 (b) The revenue bonds shall be secured by and payable from
- 10 the transient accommodations tax revenues allocated to the city
- 11 and county of Honolulu pursuant to section 237D-6.5(b)(3),

- SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the revenue bond

9	2016-2017 to provide financing for the city and county of
10	Honolulu's rail transit project.
11	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the city and
12	county of Honolulu for the purposes of this Act.

14	SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
17	provided that parts II, III, and IV shall take effect on July 1,

Amends the sunset date of the county surcharge on state tax. Authorizes the following to provide financing for the city and county of Honolulu's rail transit project: (1) Issuance of general obligation bonds for a grant-in-aid; (2) Issuance by the Hawaii tourism authority for a grant-in-aid, secured and payable by transient accommodations tax revenues allocated to the city and county of Honolulu; and (3) An appropriation from the general fund.
