A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-THIRD, THIRTY-FOURTH, AND THIRTY-FIFTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$57,285,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
5	for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6	the thirty-third, thirty-fourth, and thirty-fifth representative
7	districts, as follows:

12	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
13	capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
14	designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.
15	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
