BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that replacing Aloha

- 12 107D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- Notwithstanding section 107D-2(c), Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 14 the department of accounting and general services shall prepare
- 15 a plan to enter into a development agreement to replace Aloha
- 16 Stadium with a state-of-the-art stadium and shopping center
