BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the fee to receive a		
2	fireworks display permit, which authorizes licensed		
3	pyrotechnicians to conduct outdoor and close proximity fireworks		
4	for theatrical purposes, has not changed for thirteen years.		
5	However, the cost to process, review, and approve fireworks		
6	display permits has increased. The legislature also finds that		
7	fireworks display permit fees should increase in order to		
8	balance governmental administrative expenses.		
9	The purpose of this Act is to increase the fireworks		
10	display permit fee for aerial devices, display fireworks, or		
11	articles pyrotechnic from \$110 to \$300.		
12	SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
13	amended to read as follows:		
14	"§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the		
15	purchase and use of:		
16	(1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers		
17	upon payment of a fee of \$25;
