BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1.	Section	328J-16,	Hawaii	Revised	Statutes,	is

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1	"Cigarette vending machine" means a self-service device		
2	that dispenses cigarettes, cigars, tobacco, or any other product		
3	containing tobacco.		
4	"Lunch wagon" means a mobile vehicle designed and		
5	constructed to transport food and from which food is sold to the		
6	general public and includes, but is not limited to, manapua		
7	trucks.		
8	"Sell" or "sale" means to solicit and receive an order for;		
9	to have, keep, offer, or expose for sale; to deliver for value		
10	or in any other manner than purely gratuitously; to peddle; to		
11	keep with intent to sell; or to traffic in."		
. 12	SECTION 2. Section 328J-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
13	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:		
14	"(c) This section shall not apply:		
15	(1) Within private commercial establishments, such as		
16	stores and restaurants, where tobacco products are		
17	sold, as long as distribution is not visible to the		
18	public from outside the establishment; or		
19	(2) To commercial establishments where access to the		
20	premises by persons under [eighteen] <u>twenty-one</u> years		
21	of age is prohibited by law."		



1	SECTION 3. Section 328J-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) This section shall not apply to:
4	(1) A duty-free sales enterprise selling duty-free
5	merchandise in accordance with the provisions of title
6	19 United States Code section 1555(b), and any
7	implementing regulations; and
8	(2) Retail tobacco stores, bars, or any other
9	establishment for which the minimum age for admission
10	is [eighteen.] <u>twenty-one.</u> "
11	SECTION 4. Section 709-908, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	"§709-908 Tobacco and electronic smoking devices
14	prohibited; [minors.] persons under twenty-one years of age.
15	(1) [It] <u>From July 1, 2016, to June 30, 2019, it shall be</u>
16	unlawful to sell or furnish tobacco in any shape or form,
17	including chewing tobacco and snuff, or an electronic smoking
18	device, to a person born after June 30, 1998.
19	(2) After June 30, 2019, it shall be unlawful to sell or
20	furnish tobacco in any shape or form, including chewing tobacco
21	and snuff, or an electronic smoking device <u>,</u> to a [minor] <u>person</u>
22	under [eighteen] <u>twenty-one</u> years of age.



1	(3) From July 1, 2016, to June 30, 2019, signs using the
2	statement, "The sale of tobacco products to persons born after
3	June 30, 1998, is prohibited", shall be posted in letters at
4	least one-half inch high on or near any vending machines and at
5	or near the point of sale of any other location where tobacco
6	products or electronic smoking devices are sold.
7	[(2) Signs] <u>(4) After June 30, 2019, signs</u> using the
8	statement, "The sale of tobacco products or electronic smoking
9	devices to persons under [eighteen] <u>twenty-one</u> is prohibited",
10	shall be posted [on or near any vending machine] in letters at
11	least one-half inch high on or near any vending machines and at
12	or near the point of sale of any other location where tobacco
13	products or electronic smoking devices are sold [in letters at
14	least one half inch high].
15	[(3)] <u>(5)</u> It shall be unlawful for a [minor] <u>person</u> under
16	[eighteen] <u>twenty-one</u> years of age to purchase any tobacco
17	product [, as described under subsection (1), or an electronic
18	smoking device, as described under subsection (5).] or
19	electronic smoking device pursuant to subsection (1). This
20	provision does not apply if a person [under]:
21	(a) <u>Under</u> the age of [eighteen,] <u>twenty-one,</u> with parental
22	authorization, is participating in a controlled



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1	purchase as part of a law enforcement activity or a
2	study authorized by the department of health under the
3	supervision of law enforcement to determine the level
4	of incidence of tobacco or electronic smoking devices
5	sales to minors [+] ; or
6	(b) Was eighteen years of age or older on or before June
7	30, 2016.
8	$\left[\frac{4}{4}\right]$ (6) Any person who violates subsection (1) $\left[\frac{6}{2}\right]_{,}$
9	(2), [or both,] <u>(3), or (4)</u> shall be fined \$500 for the first
10	offense. Any subsequent offenses shall subject the person to a
11	fine not less than \$500 nor more than \$2,000. Any [minor under
12	eighteen years of age] person who violates subsection [(3)] (5)
13	shall be fined \$10 for the first offense. Any subsequent
14	offense shall subject the violator to a fine of \$50, no part of
15	which shall be suspended, or the person shall be required to
16	perform not less than forty-eight hours nor more than seventy-
17	two hours of community service during hours when the person is
18	not employed and is not attending school.
19	$\left[\frac{(5)}{(7)}\right]$ For the purposes of this section:
20	"Electronic smoking device" means any electronic product
21	that can be used to [simulate smoking in the delivery of]
22	vaporize and deliver nicotine or other substances to the person
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1 inhaling from the device [-] including, but not limited to, an
2 electronic cigarette, electronic cigar, electronic cigarillo, or
3 electronic pipe, and any cartridge or other component of the
4 device or related product."

6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
