

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to part VI, subpart A, to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§30</u>	2A- Lease of property. (a) Notwithstanding any
5	law to the	e contrary, the board, without recourse to public
6	auction or public notice for sealed bids, may lease real or	
7	personal property under the department's jurisdiction to any	
8	person, upon terms and conditions as may be approved by the	
9	board; provided that:	
10	(1)	The leased property shall be used for purposes of
11		agriculture, public utilities, renewable energy,
12		transit, or high technology development; and
13	(2)	The board may enter into a leaseback transaction with
14		the lessee.
15	(b)	For purposes of this section, "leaseback" means a
16	transaction in which the board leases property to any person,	
17	pursuant ·	to subsection (a), and thereafter subleases a portion

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- 1 of the same property or facilities thereupon from the lessee to
- 2 carry out the purposes of this chapter."
- 3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
