### A BILL FOR AN ACT

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to improve the		
2	overall health of the population in the State and reduce the

4	department of education, in collaboration with the department of		
5	health, to develop accurate, educational information on:		
6	(1) Human papillomavirus;		
7	(2) The connection between human papillomavirus and

9	cancers and diseases; and		
10	(3) The availability of vaccines against human		
11	papillomavirus;		
12	and disseminate this information through the public schools to		
13	parents or guardians of all public school students entering the		
14	sixth grade.		
15	SECTION 2. (a) Beginning with the 2016-2017 school year,		
16	each public school shall provide information on the human		
17	papillomavirus on an annual basis to each parent or guardian of
