A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that residents of the SECTION 1. island of Hawaii would greatly benefit from the addition of an 2 advanced life support ambulance to augment the Hawaii county 3 4 emergency medical services system for residents of the Makalei 5 The population of this area has significantly increased over the years, which has corresponded with a steady increase in 6 calls for emergency medical services. 7 8 The legislature further finds that access to primary health
- 9 care in Makalei is challenging for the community. For many
- 10 residents, primary care services are as many as thirty miles
- 11 away. Coupled with economic and transportation challenges,
- emergency medical services have become the access point for 12
- 13 health care to many residents.
- Due to the lack of resources, it has become common for 14
- medics to have up to ten transports in a twenty-four hour shift. 15
- 16 The potential for fatigue leading to errors in judgment,
- 17 driving, and overall safety are of great concern for personnel
- 18 and residents.

1	The legislature further finds that a new advanced life
2	support ambulance would help reduce death and disability among
3	residents and visitors on the island of Hawaii. A timely
4	response to a 911 call is critical to increase the likelihood of
5	successful outcomes for injured or sick individuals. Given the
6	island's significant growth and aging population, an advanced
7	life support ambulance is needed and would be cost-effective.
8	The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for an
9	advanced life support ambulance to be based in the Makalei area
10	on the island of Hawaii and to be used during daily peak hours
11	from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., including the acquisition of a
12	vehicle and equipment, and funding personnel costs for state-
13	certified emergency medical service personnel.
14	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
16	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
17.	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
18	2016-2017 for one advanced life support ambulance to be:
19	(1) Based in Makalei on the island of Hawaii; and
20	(2) Used during daily peak hours from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00

- 1 and to include the acquisition of a vehicle and equipment, and
- 2 funding personnel costs for state-certified emergency medical

- 4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 5 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
