A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, for farmers and
- 2 ranchers to remain competitive and self-sustaining, the State
- 3 must provide incentives and mechanisms to ensure that all means
- 4 of supporting the local agricultural industry are implemented.
- 5 The public utilities commission regulates the rates charged by
- 6 public utilities that provide essential services to the
- 7 agriculture industry such as water, interisland shipping, and
- 8 electricity.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide for preferential
- 10 rates for certain public utility services provided to ratepayers
- 11 engaged in agricultural activities.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 269-26.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 "[+]\$269-26.5[+] Preferential [water] rates for
- 15 agricultural activities. (a) It is the policy of the State to
- 16 promote the long-term viability of agriculture by establishing
- 17 mechanisms that provide for preferential rates for [potable

- 1 water for] public utility services that are provided to
- 2 ratepayers that engage in agricultural activities. The public
- 3 utilities commission [shall have the authority to] may establish
- 4 preferential rates for [potable water] water, electricity, and
- 5 freight transport services that are used by ratepayers for
- 6 agricultural activities in a public utility's service area.
- 7 (b) Upon receipt of a bona fide request for preferential
- 8 rates for [potable water] public utility services to be used for
- 9 agricultural activities[7] on lands within an agricultural
- 10 district, and proof that the customer engages in agricultural
- 11 activities $[\tau]$ on lands within an agricultural district, a public
- 12 utility shall provide proposed preferential rates for [potable
- 13 water] the requested public utility service for water,
- 14 electricity, or freight transport, and to be used only for
- 15 qualified agricultural activities to the public utilities
- 16 commission for approval. All [such] rates approved by the
- 17 public utilities commission pursuant to this section shall be
- 18 subsidized by the [potable water] rates charged to other
- 19 customers of the public utility, if required, as determined by
- 20 the public utilities commission. In reviewing the proposed
- 21 preferential rates, the public utilities commission, in

- 1 consultation with the department of agriculture, may establish
- 2 additional criteria to qualify bona fide agribusinesses for
- 3 [water] public utility services used solely for agricultural
- 4 activities. [For rate cases initiated pursuant to this section,
- 5 the public utilities commission shall allow the recovery of any
- 6 reasonable unamortized costs incurred by the public utility in
- 7 its previous rate case; provided however, upon full amortization
- 8 of these costs, rates shall be adjusted accordingly.] "
- 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
