A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to improve food
2	security and self-sufficiency in the State by:
3	(1) Establishing state planning and policy objectives for
4	the increased production of locally grown foods and
5	improved consumer access to locally grown foods;
6	(2) Encouraging the development and implementation of a
7	comprehensive approach to agriculture in Hawaii; and
8	(3) Making various appropriations accordingly.
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
11	and to read as follows:
12	"§141- Agricultural development and food security
13	program; establishment. There is established within the
14	department of agriculture an agricultural development and food
15	security program that shall have the objectives described in
16	section 226-6(a)."

1	SECT	ION 3. Section 226-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	Planning for the State's economy in general shall be
4	directed	toward achievement of the following objectives:
5	(1)	Increased and diversified employment opportunities to
6		achieve full employment, increased income and job
7		choice, and improved living standards for Hawaii's
8		people, while at the same time stimulating the
9		development and expansion of economic activities
10		capitalizing on defense, dual-use, and science and
11		technology assets, particularly on the neighbor
12		islands where employment opportunities may be limited.
13	(2)	A steadily growing and diversified economic base that
14		is not overly dependent on a few industries, and
15		includes the development and expansion of industries
16		on the neighbor islands.
17	(3)	Increased demand for and access to locally grown foods
18		by:
19		(A) Expanding local marketing campaigns to promote
20		the benefits of buying locally grown foods;

1		<u>(B)</u>	Expanding and improving branding and labeling
2			programs and providing consumer education
3			programs to help consumers identify local
4			products at the time of purchase;
5		<u>(C)</u>	Encouraging public institutions, including
6			schools, to purchase locally grown foods; and
7		(D)	Addressing food safety issues by expanding the
8		٠	farm food safety coaching program and number of
9			farm food safety certifiers.
10	(4)	Incr	eased production of locally grown foods, to
11		supp	lant mainland- or foreign-grown products by:
12		(A)	Building the agricultural workforce, including
13			workforce development services for the
14			agricultural, energy, natural resources, and
15			related industries;
16		<u>(B)</u>	Supporting the agricultural park program, which
17			provides public lands at reasonable cost and
18			long-term tenure to farmers, and completing the
19			transfer of agricultural lands from the
20			department of land and natural resources to the
21			department of agriculture;

1	<u>(C)</u>	Supporting capital improvement project funding to				
2		repair and maintain state irrigation systems that				
3		provide water at low cost to farmers;				
4	<u>(D)</u>	Encouraging a variety of distribution systems to				
5		move goods to the marketplace;				
6	<u>(E)</u>	Supporting multi-functional food hub facilities				
7		or food incubator facilities to handle				
8		aggregation, processing, value adding, treatment,				
9		and distribution; and				
10	<u>(F)</u>	Improving agricultural infrastructure, including				
11		agricultural parks, irrigation systems, and				
12		distribution systems and facilities."				
13	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general					
14	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much					
15	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the					
16	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year					
17	2016-2017 for the department of agriculture to establish an					
18	agricultural development and food security program pursuant to					
19	this Act.					
20	The sums	appropriated shall be expended by the department				
21	of agriculture	for the purposes of this Act.				

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1 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 5 2016-2017 for the department of agriculture to produce locally 6 grown agricultural product promotional materials along with 7 other endeavors, such as in-store promotions. 8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 9 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act. 10 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the 13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 14 2016-2017 for the department of agriculture to expand and 15 improve branding and labeling programs for locally grown foods. 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 17 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act. 18 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the

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- 1 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 2 2016-2017 for publicity to promote farmers' markets.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 8 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 9 2016-2017 for a farm-to-school pilot program in charter schools
- 10 of the State.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 17 2016-2017 to develop good agricultural practices for school
- 18 gardens.
- 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 20 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

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2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 5. 2016-2017 for the establishment of specialists to certify farm 6 food safety. 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 8 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act. 9 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the 12 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 13 2016-2017 to develop regional agriculture infrastructure master 14 plans.

SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general

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- 1 2016-2017 to restore positions in food inspection, pest control,
- 2 and biosecurity.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 8 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 9 2016-2017 to restore positions in market research and
- 10 agricultural statistics.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 14. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on January 20,
- **15** 2050.
