

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATED TO HARASSMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 188-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) No person shall intentionally prevent or attempt to
4	prevent the lawful taking of fish by a person permitted pursuant
5	to section 188-31, licensed pursuant to section 188-50, or
6	fishing in marine waters within the State's jurisdiction by:
7	(1) Placing the person's self in a location in which human
8	presence may affect the behavior of fish to be taken
9	or the feasibility of taking such fish;
10	(2) Creating a visual, aural, olfactory, or physical
11	stimulus to affect the behavior of fish to be taken;
12	(3) Affecting the condition or placement of personal
13	property intended for use in the taking; or
14	(4) Obstructing the person's access to areas in which the
15	person intends to lawfully take fish."
16	SECTION 2. Section 199-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

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1	"(a)	The conservation and resources enforcement officers,
2	with resp	ect to all state lands, including public lands, state
3	parks, fo	rest reserves, forests, aquatic life and wildlife
4	areas, Ka	ho'olawe island reserve, and any other lands and waters
5	within th	e State, shall:
6	(1)	Enforce title 12, chapters 6D, 6E, and 6K, and rules
7		adopted thereunder;
8	(2)	Investigate complaints, gather evidence, conduct
9		investigations, and conduct field observations and
10		inspections as required or assigned;
11	(3)	Cooperate with enforcement authorities of the State,
12		counties, and federal government in development of
13		programs and mutual aid agreements for conservation
14		and resources enforcement activities within the State;
15	(4)	Cooperate with established search and rescue agencies
16		of the counties and the federal government in
17		developing plans and programs and mutual aid
18		agreements for search and rescue activities within the
19		State;

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	(3)	check and verify arr reases, permits, and recenses
2		issued by the department of land and natural
3		resources;
4	(6)	Enforce the laws relating to firearms, ammunition, and
5		dangerous weapons contained in chapter 134;
6	(7)	Enforce the laws in chapter 291E relating to operating
7		a vessel on or in the waters of the State while using
8		intoxicants;
9	(8)	Enforce the laws relating to harassment, specifically,
10		criminal harassment pursuant to section 711-1106,
11		hunter harassment pursuant to section 183D-27.5, and
12		harassment of fishermen pursuant to section 188-71;
13	[(8)]	(9) Whether through a specifically designated marine
14		patrol or otherwise, enforce the rules in the areas of
15		boating safety, conservation, and search and rescue
16		relative to the control and management of boating
17		facilities owned or controlled by the State, ocean
18		waters, and navigable streams and any activities
19		thereon or therein, and beaches encumbered with
20		easements in favor of the public, and the rules

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1	regulating vessels and their use in the waters of the
2	State; and
3	[-(9)] (10) Carry out other duties and responsibilities as
4	the board of land and natural resources from time to
5	time may direct."
6	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8	begun before its effective date.
9	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
