

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "S6E-3 Historic preservation program. There is
- 4 established within the department a division to administer a
- 5 comprehensive historic preservation program, which shall include
- 6 but not be limited to the following:
- 7 (1) Development of an ongoing program of historical,
- 8 architectural, and archaeological research and
- 9 development, including surveys, excavations,
- scientific recording, interpretation, signage, and
- 11 publications on the State's historical and cultural
- 12 resources;
- 13 (2) Acquisition of historic or cultural properties, real
- or personal, in fee or in any lesser interest, by
- 15 gift, purchase, condemnation, devise, bequest, land
- 16 exchange, or other means; preservation, restoration,

1		administration, or transference of the property; and
2		the charging of reasonable admissions to that
3		property;
4	(3)	Development of a statewide survey and inventory to
5		identify and document historic properties, aviation
6		artifacts, and burial sites, including all those owned
7		by the State and the counties;
8	(4)	Preparation of information for the Hawaii register of
9		historic places and listing on the national register
10		of historic places;
11	(5)	Preparation, review, and revisions of a state historic
12		preservation plan, including budget requirements and
13		land use recommendations;
14	(6)	Application for and receipt of gifts, grants,
15		technical assistance, and other funding from public
16		and private sources for the purposes of this chapter;
17	(7)	Provision of technical and financial assistance to the
18		counties and public and private agencies involved in
19		historic preservation activities;

1	(8)	8) Coordination of activities of the countles in	
2		accordance with the state plan for historic	
3		preservation;	
4	(9)	Stimulation of public interest in historic	
5		preservation, including the development and	
6		implementation of interpretive programs for historic	
7		properties listed on or eligible for the Hawaii	
8		register of historic places;	
9	(10)	Coordination of the evaluation and management of	
10		burial sites as provided in section 6E-43;	
11	(11)	Acquisition of burial sites in fee or in any lesser	
12		interest, by gift, purchase, condemnation, devise,	
13		bequest, land exchange, or other means, to be held in	
14		trust;	
15	(12)	Submittal of an annual report to the governor and	
16		legislature detailing the accomplishments of the year,	
17		recommendations for changes in the state plan or	
18		future programs relating to historic preservation, and	
19		an accounting of all income, expenditures, and the	
20		fund balance of the Hawaii historic preservation	
21		special fund;	



1	(13)	Regulation of archaeological activities throughout the				
2		State;				
3	(14)	Employment of sufficient professional and technical				
4		staff for the purposes of this chapter which shall be				
5		in accordance with chapter 76;				
6	(15)	The charging of fees to be determined by the				
7		department that are proportional to the nature and				
8		complexity of the projects or services provided, and				
9		adjusted from time to time to ensure that the				
10		proceeds, together with all other fines, income, and				
11		penalties collected under this chapter, do not surpass				
12		the annual operating costs of the comprehensive				
13		historic preservation program; provided that:				
14		(A) Fees shall be charged in accordance with a				
15		schedule adopted by the board of land and natural				
16		resources;				
17		(B) Any fee schedule proposed for adoption shall be				
18		posted on the department's website at least				
19		forty-five days prior to the meeting of the board				
20		of land and natural resources at which the				
21	·	adoption will be considered;				

1		<u>(C)</u>	The board of land and natural resources shall
2			consider and adopt a fee schedule at a regular
3			meeting after taking public testimony; and
4		<u>(D)</u>	Setting of the fees shall not be subject to
5			<pre>chapter 91;</pre>
6	(16)	Adop	tion of rules in accordance with chapter 91,
7		nece	ssary to carry out the purposes of this chapter;

9	(17)	Deve:	lopment and adoption, in consultation with the
10		offi	ce of Hawaiian affairs native historic
11		pres	ervation council, of rules governing permits for
12		acce	ss by native Hawaiians and Hawaiians to cultural,
13		hist	oric, and pre-contact sites and monuments."
