- 1 SECTION 1. Section 78-29, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Each chief executive may establish incentive and 4 service awards programs to recognize employees who contribute to
- 5 the efficiency, economy, or other improvement of government
- 6 operations or who perform exceptionally meritorious special acts
- 7 or services in the public interest in connection with or related
- to their official employment. The programs may allow appointing 8
- 9 authorities to establish their own programs that are consistent
- with the policies of the chief executive." 10
- 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
