- 8 or employees any adjustment or increase in the officer's or
- 9 employee's respective salary or compensation where such
- 10 adjustment or increase constitutes a mandatory adjustment or
- 11 increase which is, directly or indirectly, dependent upon and
- 12 related to negotiated salary adjustments or increases received
- 13 under collective bargaining agreements by civil service or other
- 14 public employees covered by collective bargaining: any elected
- 15 or appointed officer or employee in the executive and judicial
- 16 branches of state government and the executive branch of any
- 17 county government (1) whose salary or compensation is fixed,

- 1 limited, or otherwise specified by statute, ordinance, or other
- 2 legislative enactment whether or not in express dollar amounts
- 3 or express dollar amount ceilings; (2) who is not subject to
- 4 chapter 76; and (3) who is excluded from collective bargaining
- 5 and not subject to chapter 89C."
- 6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
