A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the equitable
- 2 provision of employee benefits by the University of Hawaii is a
- 3 matter of statewide concern. Currently, the University of
- 4 Hawaii provides its faculty with educational benefits, but those
- 5 same benefits are not afforded to nonsupervisory employees in
- 6 blue collar positions and some similarly situated officers and
- 7 employees.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to require the University of
- 9 Hawaii to provide nonsupervisory employees in blue collar
- 10 positions and similarly situated officers and employees who are
- 11 excluded from collective bargaining with the same educational
- 12 benefits provided to faculty of the University of Hawaii and the
- 13 community college system.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to part III, subpart A, to be
- 16 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
