

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CHIEF ELECTION OFFICER.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
  - 3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read:
  - 4 "(b) The chief election officer shall be responsible for
  - 5 the maximization of registration of eligible electors and voter
  - 6 turnout throughout the State. In maximizing registration, the
  - 7 chief election officer shall make an effort to equalize
  - 8 registration between districts, with particular effort in those
  - 9 districts in which the chief election officer determines
- 10 registration is lower than desirable. The chief election
- 11 officer, in carrying out this function, may make surveys, carry
- 12 on house-to-house canvassing, and assist or direct the clerk in
- any other area of registration[+] or voter turnout."
- 14 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:
- "(d) The chief election officer shall be responsible for
- 16 public education with respect to voter registration and
- 17 information [-], and voter turnout."



- 1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
