A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that certain motorcycles
- 2 with three wheels are designed to accommodate the operator and a
- 3 passenger sitting side by side, rather than astride a seat with
- 4 one leg on each side of the motorcycle. However, statutes
- 5 regulating the operation of motorcycles do not currently
- 6 recognize or provide for the operation of that type of the state of
- 7 motorcycle, thus preventing the legal sale and operation of
- 8 otherwise roadworthy vehicles in the State.
- 9 The legislature further finds that Hawaii is the only state
- 10 in the nation in which this type of three-wheeled motorcycle is
- 11 not recognized as a legal means of transportation. This lack of
- 12 recognition is based on statutory provisions that are meant to
- 13 apply only to traditional two-wheeled motorcycles, rather than
- 14 on safety concerns regarding the operation of motorcycles with
- 15 three wheels.

1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to permit operators 2 and passengers of motorcycles with three wheels to ride side by 3 side on motorcycles that are designed for them to ride that way. 4 Section 291C-152, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 6 "(b) A person shall ride upon a motorcycle only while 7 sitting astride the seat, facing forward, with one leg on each 8 side of the motorcycle[-]; provided that a person riding upon a 9 motorcycle with three wheels that is designed to permit an 10 operator and passenger to sit on seats positioned side by side 11 shall not be required to sit astride a seat with one leg on each 12 side of the motorcycle." SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15
