

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PHARMACISTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I of article 10A to be
- 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$431:10A- Reimbursement for laboratory tests ordered
- 5 by pharmacists. All individual and group accident and health
- 6 or sickness policies under this article that provide
- 7 reimbursement for drugs dispensed by a pharmacist who is
- 8 licensed under chapter 461 shall also provide reimbursement for
- 9 drug therapy related laboratory tests that are within the scope
- 10 of practice and ordered by the pharmacist in connection with the
- 11 dispensing of the drugs."
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new section to part VI of article 1 to be
- 14 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 15 "§432:1- Reimbursement for laboratory tests ordered by
- 16 pharmacists. All individual and group hospital and medical
- 17 service plan contracts and medical service corporation contracts



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- 1 under this article that provide reimbursement for drugs
- 2 dispensed by a pharmacist who is licensed under chapter 461
- 3 shall also provide reimbursement for drug therapy related
- 4 laboratory tests ordered by the pharmacist in connection with
- 5 the dispensing of the drugs."
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 "\$432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
- 9 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
- 10 policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
- 11 January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
- 12 this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections
- 13 431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116, 431:10A-
- 14 116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120, 431:10A-121,
- 15 431:10A-125, 431:10A-126, 431:10A-122, 431:10A- , and 431:10A-
- 16 116.2, and chapter 431M."
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 18 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 19 begun before its effective date.
- 20 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
