

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN SCIENTIFIC CONTRACTS WITH THE UNITED STATES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 238-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 3 "(j) The tax imposed by this chapter shall not apply to
- 4 any use of property, services, or contracting exempted by
- 5 [section 237-26 or] section 237-29."
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 237-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 repealed.
- 8 ["\$237-26 Exemption of certain scientific contracts with
- 9 the United States. (a) Any provision of law to the contrary
- 10 notwithstanding, there shall be exempted from the measure of the
- 11 taxes imposed by chapter 237, all of the gross proceeds derived
- 12 by a contractor or subcontractor arising from the performance of
- 13 any scientific work as defined in subsection (b), under a
- 14 contract or subcontract entered into with the United States
- 15 (including any agency or instrumentality thereof but not
- 16 including national banks), and all of the gross proceeds derived

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- 2 tangible personal property to such contractor or subcontractor;
- 3 provided the exemption herein shall apply only to such tangible
- 4 personal property which is to be affixed to, or to become a
- 5 physical, integral part of the scientific facility, or which is
- 6 to be entirely consumed during the performance of the service
- 7 required by the contract or subcontract.
- 8 (b) For purposes of this section, "scientific work" is
- 9 work involving primarily the research and development for, or
- 10 the design, manufacture, instrumentation, installation,
- 11 maintenance, or operation of aerospace, agricultural,
- 12 astronomical, biomedical, electronic, geophysical,
- 13 oceanographic, test range, or other scientific facilities.
- 14 Maintenance or operation, for purposes of this section, shall
- 15 include housekeeping functions in providing certain
- 16 nonscientific logistic and support services."]
- 17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
