Section 89-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 3 "(d) For the purpose of negotiating a collective 4 bargaining agreement, the public employer of an appropriate 5 bargaining unit shall mean the governor together with the 6 following employers: 7 For bargaining units (1), (2), (3), (4), $[\frac{(9)}{7}]$ (10), (1)8 (13), and (14), the governor shall have six votes and 9 the mayors, the chief justice, and the Hawaii health 10 systems corporation board shall each have one vote if 11 they have employees in the particular bargaining unit; 12 (2) For bargaining units (11) and (12), the governor shall 13 have four votes and the mayors shall each have one 14 vote; 15 For bargaining units (5) and (6), the governor shall (3) 16 have [three] four votes, the board of education shall 17 have two votes, [and] the superintendent of education
