# A BILL FOR AN ACT

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 378, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>\$</u> 37	8- Anti-discrimination and harassment procedures.
5	(a) Ever	y employer shall implement policies and procedures that
6	prohibit a	and prevent unlawful discriminatory practices in the
7	workplace	, in accordance with section 378-2. These policies and
8	procedure	s shall, at minimum, include the following:
9	(1)	Annual training;
10	(2)	Educational materials that outline the consequences
11		for specific violations, which shall be commensurate
12		with the severity of the offense; and
13	(3)	A confidential system of reporting that encourages
14		reporting of violations.
15	(b)	The policies and procedures in subsection (a) shall be
16	submitted	to, reviewed, and approved by the department.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
