
- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 347, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§347- Knowing misrepresentation as owner or trainer of
- 5 service dog; penalty. (a) Any person who knowingly and
- 6 fraudulently represents the person, through verbal or written
- 7 notice, as the owner or trainer of a dog that is qualified as or
- 8 identified as a service dog shall be guilty of a misdemeanor
- 9 punishable by imprisonment for not more than six months or a
- 10 fine of not more than \$1,000, or both.
- (b) As used in this section, "owner" means any person who
- 12 owns a service dog or who is authorized by the owner to use the
- 13 service dog."
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
