14	the central service assessment of any fund. No later than
15	twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session of
16	the legislature, the director shall report all central service
17	assessments made during the preceding fiscal year."
18	SECTION 2. Chapter 342G, part VII, Hawaii Revised
19	Statutes, is repealed.
20	SECTION 3. The director of finance shall abolish the
21	special account in the environmental management fund established



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1 pursuant to section 342G-84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and shall transfer any unencumbered balance remaining, as of June 30, 2 3 2015, to the credit of the general fund. 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval; 5 provided that the amendments made to section 36-27, Hawaii 6 Revised Statutes, by section 1 of this Act shall not be repealed when section 36-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is reenacted 7 8 pursuant to section 34 of Act 79, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009. 9
