RELATING TO STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL TIME.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:

4	Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, beginning with

9	instructional days negotiated pursuant to chapter 89.

4	(c) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
5	2014 2016 school years, all public secondary schools, excluding

9	(d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
10	2016-2018 school years, all public-schools, excluding-charter
11	schools and multi track-public schools, shall implement a school
12	year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional
13	development days and other non instructional days negotiated
14	pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include one thousand eighty
15	student instructional hours for both elementary and secondary
16	school grades.
17	(e) The board, in its discretion, may grant a waiver to
18	any individual-school subject to the student-instructional hours
19	or one hundred eighty-day school year-requirements in-this
20	section. The board shall adopt policies—and procedures to grant
21	a waiver under this subsection.
