RELATING TO THE UNIFORM AERONAUTICS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 263-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "S263-10 Hunting from aircraft; penalty. (a) Any
- 4 aeronaut or passenger who, while in flight in, across, or above
- 5 the State, intentionally kills or attempts to kill any birds or
- 6 animals shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine
- 7 of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than
- 8 one year, or both.
- 9 (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, state
- 10 employees and independent contractors retained by the State may,
- 11 while in flight in, across, or above the State, intentionally
- 12 kill or attempt to kill any wildlife in furtherance of official
- 13 state duties; provided that actions taken under this section,
- 14 shall be limited to remote and inaccessible areas, where access
- 15 to wildlife may pose hazard to human life."
- 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
