

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. - 6 2016-2017 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 8 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 12 provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2015.

Department of Health; Website; Care-Home Vacancy
