14	public safety law enforcement vehicles, [and] conservation and		
15	resources enforcement vehicles, and department of transportation		
16	division of harbors law enforcement vehicles authorized and		
17	approved pursuant to section 291-31.5 that are publicly owned		
18	and other publicly or privately owned vehicles designated as		
19	such by a county council."

- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun, before the effective date of this Act.

- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
