SECTION 1. Act 134, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, as 1 amended by section 4(4) of Act 122, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014, 2 is amended by amending section 5.1 to read as follows: 3 "SECTION 5.1. Provided that of the general fund 4 5 appropriation for general administration (LBR902), the sum of 6 [\$450,000,] \$200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015, shall be expended for the purpose of 7 8 accrued vacation payments for all employees leaving the employ of the department of labor and industrial relations; provided 9 further that the department shall first make payments from the 10 vacation payout allocation before expending funds from turnover 11 12 and vacancy amounts; provided further that the respective nongeneral fund shall reimburse the general fund for any payments 13 made for accrued vacation payments; and provided further that 14 any unexpended funds shall lapse to the general fund at the end 15 of the fiscal year for which the appropriation was made." 16
