Small Boat Harbors; Permit; Waitlist

Description:

Clarifies that a person at least eighteen years of age need not obtain a marine surveyor's inspection nor provide documentation that the person is the owner of a vessel in order to be placed on a waitlist for a use permit to moor a vessel in a state small boat harbor.

TITIE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO USE PERMITS FOR SMALL BOAT HARBORS.

PURPOSE:

To clarify that a person, at least eighteen years of age, need not obtain a marine surveyor's inspection, nor provide documentation that the person is the owner of a vessel, in order to be placed on a waitlist for a use permit to moor a vessel in a state small boat harbor.

MEANS:

Amend section 200-10(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION:

Act 10, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014, amended section 200-10(b), HRS, requiring that a person must be at least eighteen years of age prior to obtaining a use permit or being placed on a waitlist for a use permit.

However, the manner in which the statutory language in the Act was structured has the unintended consequence of requiring that a person at least eighteen years of age:

- (1) Obtain a marine surveyor's inspection no more than two years old, certifying that the surveyor has inspected the vessel and considers it to fulfill the requirements set by the Department, and
- (2) Provide documentation that the person is the owner of a vessel,

prior to being placed on the waitlist for a use permit. This is unrealistic as the majority of people requesting to be placed on the waitlist do not own a vessel at the time since they do not have a place to moor the vessel.

Impact on the public: Persons at least eighteen years of age applying to be placed on the waitlist would not be required to first obtain a marine surveyor's inspection

nor provide documentation that the person is the owner of a vessel.
