A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
·3	and to read as follows:
4	"§304A- University of Hawaii at Manoa; office of the
5	ombuds. (a) There is established at the University of Hawaii
6	at Manoa the office of the ombuds, which shall be attached
7	administratively to the chancellor of the University of Hawaii
8	at Manoa.
9	(b) The office of the ombuds shall provide assistance to,
10	and enhance the communication of, the views and voices of
11	faculty, students, staff, and the surrounding community through
12	investigation, analysis, mediation, and public reporting.
13	Assistance provided by the office of the ombuds shall include:
14	(1) Providing an office to register confidential
15	complaints, problems, or issues:
16	(A) Confidentiality shall be granted upon request
17	unless disclosure is otherwise required by law or

1		there exists an imminent risk of serious harm;
2		and
3		(B) Ombuds staff shall not disclose the identity of
4		persons who seek assistance, and the contents of
5		communications with those persons, or third
6		parties the person requesting assistance
7		authorizes ombuds staff to contact, shall be
8		privileged. The privilege may be waived only by
9		the office of the ombuds;
10	(2)	Providing impartial and neutral advocacy for fair
11		processes, considering the rights of all parties, and
12		taking no personal stake in the outcome of any matter
13		brought to the attention of the office of ombuds; and
14	(3)	Operating as an independent office not directed or
15		limited by the chancellor of the University of Hawaii
16		at Manoa in the course of providing assistance in any
17		particular matter and shall observe the
18		confidentiality required by paragraph (1) in any
19		communications with the chancellor regarding its
20		handling of matters, generally.

1	<u>(c)</u>	Issues that may be brought to the attention of the
2	office of	the ombuds shall include the following:
3	(1)	Communicating the views and voices of students,
4		faculty, and staff to decision makers;
5	(2)	Harassment or discrimination;
6	(3)	Violations of University of Hawaii at Manoa policy;
7	(4)	Professional and organizational disputes;
8	(5)	<pre>Ethical dilemmas;</pre>
9	(6)	Cultural misunderstandings;
10	(7)	Conflicts of interest;
11	(8)	Student employment issues and disputes;
12	(9)	Assistance to administrators and regents in analyzing
13		and framing difficult issues;
14	(10)	Disputes between the university and the community at
15		large;
16	(11)	Health and safety concerns;
17	(12)	Availability and transparency of public information
18		regarding university policies, finances, decisions,
19		and programs;
20	(13)	Academic freedom; and
21	(14)	Threats or retaliation.

9			other resources;
10		(D)	Facilitate communication, whether directly or
11			indirectly; and
12		<u>(E)</u>	Provide other services, including mediation,
13			reasonably necessary to fulfill the purposes of
14			this section; and
15	(2)	May 1	not:
16		(A)	Make policy or administrative decisions on behalf
17			of administrators or staff;
18		(B)	Establish, change, or set aside policies of the
19			University of Hawaii at Manoa;
20		(C)	Offer legal advice or psychological counseling;

1	(D)	Participate in grievances or other formal dis	pute		
2		resolution processes; or			
3	<u>(E)</u>	Serve as an agent of notice for University of	: <u>·</u>		
4		Hawaii at Manoa or as an advocate for any per	son		
5		seeking assistance.

7	shall have acc	ess to and have authority to track statistics

10	recommendations for institutional improvements, to the

13	(f) All	offices and employees of the University of Haw	aii_		
14	at Manoa shall	timely respond to and provide assistance as			
15	reasonably req	uested by the office of the ombuds. As necess	ary,		
16	the chancellor	of the University of Hawaii at Manoa shall us	<u>e</u>		
17	the powers of	the chancellor's office to secure the assistan	<u>ice</u>		
18	required by th	is subsection."			
19	SECTION 2	. There is appropriated out of the general			
20	revenues of th	e State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so	,		
21	much thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 a	ınd		

- 1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 2 year 2016-2017 to establish and operate the office of the ombuds
- 3 at the University of Hawaii at Manoa.
- 4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 5 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
