BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

6	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of

8	SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the project
9	authorized by this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal
10	biennium for which the appropriation is made; provided that all
11	moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2018,
12	shall lapse as of that date.
13	SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
14	on July 1, 2015.
