
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO CONDUCT A SAFETY
STUDY ON THE LANA'I AIRPORT BASE YARD.

1 WHEREAS, an interim baseyard at the Lana'i Airport is being
2 rented and used by personnel for work purposes; and

3
4 WHEREAS, the current baseyard facility has limited
5 resources for use by employees and a move to a permanent
6 facility can provide for more room for additional resources; and

7
8 WHEREAS, a ten-acre parcel of land, conveyed to the State
9 by Dole Company when it reclassified certain lands on Lana'i for
10 the development of Manele Golf Course, abuts the airport
11 property along Kaumalapau Highway on Lana'i and is available for
12 state agencies to use; and

13
14 WHEREAS, the Highways Division of the Department of
15 Transportation, in collaboration with the Department of Land and
16 Natural Resources, is working to acquire an additional two acre
17 parcel adjacent to the Lana'i Airport for the purpose of
18 constructing a permanent baseyard for Lana'i crewmembers; and

19
20 WHEREAS, an environmental study and safety assessment of
21 these properties adjacent to Lana'i Airport will help in the
22 process of developing the area for use; and

23
24 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of stakeholders to
25 establish a permanent baseyard facility adjacent to the Lana'i
26 airport that is environmentally and structurally safe for
27 employees to use; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 2 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
 3 Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
 4 Transportation is requested to conduct a safety study on the
 5 Lana'i airport base yard; and

 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in conducting its study, the
 8 Department of Transportation shall survey the area to identify
 9 specific improvements necessary to ensure the area is
 10 environmentally and structurally safe for employees; and

 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 13 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
 14 Transportation.
