

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO ASSESS THE PROBABLE EFFECTS OF LICENSING AND REGULATING YOUTH SPORTS COACHES.

1 2	WHEREAS, youth sports play an important part in the character development of children; and

4 5	WHEREAS, participation in youth sports contributes to moral development, teaches valuable social skills, and instills
6	leadership qualities in young people; and

8	WHEREAS, research has shown that the quality of a child's
9	sport experience often depends on the quality of the coaching

12	WHEREAS, in many instances, a coach has an important impact
13	on a child's life; and

15	WHEREAS, the Legislature believes that regulating youth
16	sports coaches, as provided in H.B. No. , Regular Session
17	of 2016, will help ensure that the children of this State
18 19	receive quality coaching in a safe environment; and
20	WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires
21	new regulatory measures that would subject unregulated
22	professions and vocations to licensing or other regulatory
23	controls to be referred by concurrent resolution to the Auditor
