## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CHIEF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH EMERGENCY
MEDICAL SERVICES AND INJURY PREVENTION SYSTEM BRANCH TO
CONVENE AND CHAIR A WORKING GROUP TO DEVELOP A COMMUNITY
PARAMEDIC PROGRAM, INCLUDING EDUCATIONAL STANDARDS FOR
CERTIFICATIONS, TO ALLEVIATE EMERGENCY SERVICES FROM
RESPONDING TO NON-EMERGENCY CALLS.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu Emergency Medical Services ran almost ninety thousand calls in 2015; and

WHEREAS, of these calls, many are from repeat callers who call multiple times per day for issues that do not need emergency services, but rather general assistance; and

WHEREAS, as the call volume rises each year and the number of ambulance stations remains the same, it is critical to develop proposals to establish community paramedic services to provide the appropriate services for these repeat callers who would otherwise be using resources that could best serve individuals who need emergency medical services; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Chief of the Department of Health Emergency Medical Services and Injury Prevention System Branch is requested to convene and chair a working group to develop a community paramedic program, including educational standards for certifications, to alleviate emergency services from responding to non-emergency calls; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group include the following members:
